2. Fixtures and season start update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Confirmation that both the York Senior League and York Val league will commence on 24-Apr-2021.</li><li>There are likely to be some Covid-19 restrictions as per the 2020 season, the league are yet to confirm these.</li><li>DW asked if there were likely to be any clashes with football given some football seasons are going to play into the summer. AC confirmed that both teams are playing their first 2 fixtures away and football are not permitted to play matches on the field after 1<sup>st</sup> May.</li><li>GB had been asked by Staxton for a pre-season friendly. DS confirmed he will be able to help where possible.</li><li>• A pre-season ground works day was arranged for Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> April at 12:00. As many club members as possible should try to make it along.</li></ul>
5. Player numbers/recruitment Update	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Numbers look good for the 1<sup>st</sup> team, concerns for the 2<sup>nd</sup> team persist but it is believed enough players will be available to field 2 teams.</li><li>• GB listed several contacts who he is hoping to play for the club.</li></ul>
